WHAT: A chance to race a Half Marathon around Hontoon Island State Park or a 10k stake race on the St. Johns River and Lake Beresford in DeLand Florida. This event is open to Rowing 1x's, 2x's and 4x's and paddle craft such as Surf skis, racing kayaks and canoes. Concept is to join those athletes who like to face backwards and forwards in a combined event. #messingaboutinboats will be the theme of the day.

All Rowing shells will race first to ensure safe passage around Hontoon Island and on the 10k course. Paddle craft will start after the rowers, safety boats will be on hand to insure safety.



WHEN: The event will be on Saturday March 30th with registration starting at 8am, Flag Ceremony at 9am, Rowing Start at 9:50 and Paddle Start at 10:00am sharp.

WHO: Masters and Junior Scullers/ Paddlers are welcome to attend and enjoy the row around the course. Race Categories will be designated by age, gender and boat type.

WHY: Why Not? This is an excellent chance to row or race a completely unique course in the state of Florida, Rowing/Paddling a loop Half Marathon and a 10k stake race is fun!
